



Baptism FAQs

COVID QUESTIONS:

- Indoor baptismal water is specially treated for your protection.
- We'll ask that you be masked both while you wait in line to be baptized, and after you are baptized (those will be provided to you). You will remove your mask while in the baptismal pool.
- We are asking that you follow the 6-foot social distancing guidelines throughout the Baptism process.

CHECK-IN:

- Please plan on arriving 30 minutes prior to service starting for a brief orientation and welcome.

WHAT TO WEAR:

- Wear the clothes in which you'll be baptized.
- Suggested clothing: dark clothes, long shorts or leggings, swimsuits under clothing (no short shorts, please).
- Bring an extra outfit to change into after getting baptized. After check-in, you will be shown a secure location where you can store your dry clothes and other belongings.
- Bring your own towel. You will receive a towel when you come out of the pool for use while in the building. You may need an extra towel for your way home.
- You will receive a special baptism t-shirt where you can write a word or phrase.

BAPTISM CERTIFICATES AND PHOTOS:

- Baptism certificates will be mailed to you following your baptism service.
- A photo will be taken of your baptism and can be provided to you by your campuses.

MINIMUM AGE FOR BAPTISM:

- 6th grade is the minimum age for baptism.
- Dedications for children younger than 6th grade can be scheduled with your campus.
